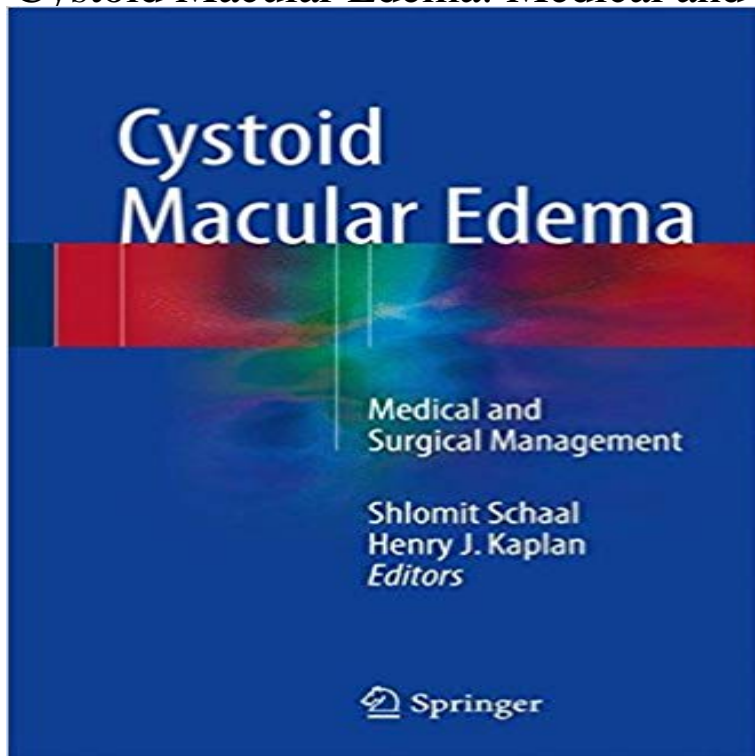


Cystoid Macular Edema: Medical and Surgical Management
